

Fracture (15) review

Nine members watched the thriller "Fractured" on Wednesday 11th June.

Anthony Hopkins plays Ted Crawford, who we see brutally shoot his unfaithful wife. He is arrested and the Deputy D A Willy Beachum, played by Ryan Gosling, believes that his conviction is a foregone conclusion. At trial, Crawford has his confession evidence thrown out as "fruit of the poisonous tree", leaving it to Beachum to prove how Crawford committed the crime.

Both the leads are very watchable actors, although we felt that Hopkin's accent varied a bit from time to time. The plot is clever and the denouement well executed, as we find out the truth.

A very good film. The title seemed a bit strange, but it is alluding to both the fracture in Crawford's marriage and the collapse of the case against him. Some nice touches of humour made the film seem real, with the only gripe being the amount of product placement (Apple Macs being the obvious examples).
